MISSION

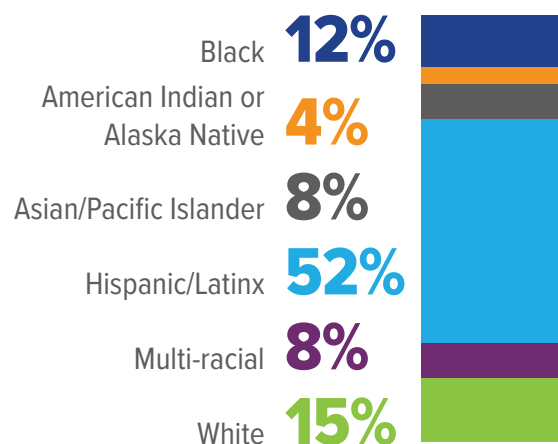

STEM PROGRAMMING

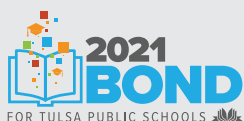

At Kerr Elementary, we depend on our community partners to thrive! QuikTrip, one of our most active Partners in Education, pays for transportation costs for an annual field trip for each grade level.
